**RECIPE CORNER**

**Fruit Cocktail Dessert**

Preheat oven to 325 degrees

**Topping:**

Measure into a small bowl and set aside:

½ cup chopped nuts

½ cup brown sugar

Measure into a mixing bowl:

1 cup sugar

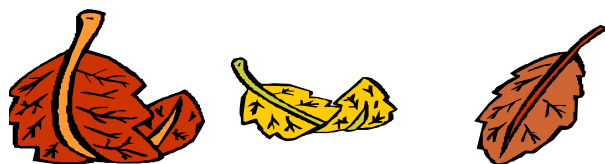
1 cup flour

1 tsp. baking soda

¼ tsp. salt

Beat one egg in a small bowl. Drain a 16 oz. can of fruit cocktail completely and add fruit cocktail to the egg. Mix with spoon until fruit is evenly covered. Mix fruit with dry ingredients. Pour into an 8x8 pan. Sprinkle topping mixture evenly. Bake for 1 hour.

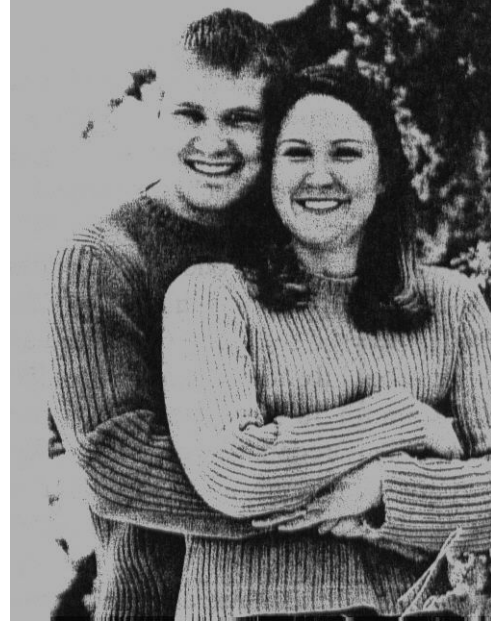

## Omelet Casserole

20 eggs  
2 c. milk  
¼ tsp. pepper  
1 ½ c. shredded cheese  
1 ½ c. diced ham

Beat eggs, milk and pepper together until blended. Stir in cheese and ham. Pour into a greased 9x13 pan.

Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 40-45 minutes, or until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean (cover with foil if the top browns too quickly). Let stand 5 minutes before cutting. Makes 12 servings ( Found in the Taste of Home A/M 2006 issue)

## Egg and Sausage Bake

2 ½ c. seasoned croutons  
2 ¼ cups shredded cheese (save 1 cup)  
1 1/2c. Jimmy Dean sausage(1 roll) fried and drained  
4 eggs  
2 ½ c. milk  
3/4 tsp. dry mustard  
pepper

Mix all together and out into a greased 9x13 pan. Refrigerate overnight.

### In the morning mix:

1 can cream of mushroom soup  
½ c. milk

Pour over crouton mixture, sprinkle remaining cheese on top. Bake at 300 degrees for 1 1/2 hours. Let sit for 5 minutes before serving. Makes 12 servings.

You can use bacon, or ham instead of the sausage.
