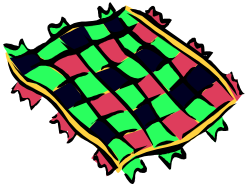

This Veterans Day we are still at war, not only do we have troops in Iraq and Afghanistan, but we have our forces spread all over the world. It is hard to imagine, but we have troops in 144 nations around the world (490,000 of them). In some countries we have only 114 troops, Iraq has 168,000. Some of the countries have a lot of our troops, but we still have 875,000 personnel in the continental United States.

At any given time we have over 115,000 Naval people both at sea and in ports, and over 3,000 National Guard troops are stationed along the Mexican border that support the Border Patrol. I could list all the countries we are involved with, but space is limited. This Veterans Day take time to think of our great country and what all our Veterans have done and are doing for all of us.


