A Message from Pastor Bruce

We are in the season of Epiphany. This is a word that predates Christianity. According to Wikipedia it means:

"An epiphany (from the ancient Greek ἐπιφάνεια, *epiphaneia*, "manifestation, striking appearance") is an experience of sudden and striking realization. Generally the term is used to describe scientific breakthrough, religious or philosophical discoveries, but it can apply in any situation in which an enlightening realization allows a problem or situation to be understood from a new and deeper perspective. Epiphanies are studied by psychologists and other scholars, particularly those attempting to study the process of innovation. Epiphanies are relatively rare occurrences and generally follow a process of significant thought about a problem. Often they are triggered by a new and key piece of information, but importantly, a depth of prior knowledge is required to allow the leap of understanding. Famous epiphanies include Archimedes's discovery of a method to determine the density of an object

("Eureka!") and Isaac Newton's realization that a falling apple and the orbiting moon are both pulled by the same force."

While the definition above conveys a generic sense of the meaning of the word Epiphany, as Christians we understand that it means the revelation of God's breaking into the world through the birth, life, death and ultimately the resurrection of His Son Jesus Christ. The privilege of Sunday worship during this season is to distill from this cosmic event a sense of what this intervention means to us personally. Please come to hear, to learn and to be inspired by this task that ultimately is not ours but is God's done for you and me.

1 egg

Pinch of salt

1/2 tsp soda

1 cup powdered sugar

2 cups flour

1 tsp vanilla

1/2 tsp cream of tartar

Directions

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- Mix all ingredients together
- Roll into small balls
- Press onto baking sheet with the sugar-coated bottom of a glass.
- Bake 8-10 minutes until light brown
